We provide an independent opinion on **Chapter 1 of Budget Paper 5**: **Statement of Finances.** 

This chapter is called the 'Estimated financial statements for the general government sector (EFS)'.

### We do not provide:

- an opinion on any budget papers other than EFS
- assurance that budgeted and forecast financial results will be achieved
- assurance on:
  - the government's fiscal strategy
- financial policy objectives
- operational and assets initiatives.

# Our review opinion

We conclude if the EFS prepared by the Department of Treasury and Finance is:

1

consistent with the accounting policies outlined

2

consistent with the current financial policy objectives and strategies statement targets

3

based on assumptions in the state Budget



based on assumptions determined using reasonable methodologies.

### How we form our opinion

We conduct:

- enquiries
- movement analysis.

### We review:

assumptions, methods and evidence, depending on how risky, large, or complex a financial transaction or balance is.


### We obtain:
